MINUTES OF THE BENEFITS AND COMPENSATION COMMITTEE MARCH 2, 2017

The Benefits and Compensation Committee of Houston First Corporation (the "Corporation"), a Texas non-profit corporation created and organized by the City of Houston as a local government corporation pursuant to TEX.TRANSP.CODE ANN. §431.101 et seq. and TEX.LOC.GOV'T.CODE ANN §394.001 et seq., held a meeting in the Partnership Tower, 2nd floor, Conference Room 2, 701 Avenida de las Americas, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77010, on Thursday, March 2, 2017, commencing at 10:00 A.M.
