The Joint Sales Committee of Houston First Corporation (the "Corporation" or "HFC"), a Texas local corporation created and organized by the City of Houston as a local government corporation pursuant to TEX. TRANSP. CODE ANN. §431.101 et seq. and TEX LOC. GOV'T. CODE ANN. §394.001 et seq. held a meeting at Partnership Tower, 701 Avenida de las Americas, Houston, Harris County, Texas, 77010, on Thursday, March 28, 2019, commencing at 10:00 a.m.

3. Presentations and Reports.

A. <u>JLL Update</u>. A representative of Jones Lang LaSalle discussed the Sales Department Citywide Report. He informed the Committee that the sales team must work a net number of 1,500 prospects in order to achieve HFC's sales goals for the year and continues to add new prospects.

Scott Cotton asked HFC staff why they chose to track prospects rather than tentative bookings and the representative from JLL provided additional information.

A diagram for future year bookings was presented to the Committee by John Solis. According to Mr. Solis, the year 2020 will be a record-breaking year for HFC.

Tom Netting suggested that HFC staff re-calibrate its sales goals based on the information presented.
